BALANCE DUE: Sunday, June 13th (All Medical Forms are due by June 13th also!)

Total cost: \$545 minus non-refundable deposit of \$50 = \$495

After June 13th the total cost is \$570.

Reminder: If you cancel your reservation after June 13th, no refund will be given. You will be responsible for the full cost of camp.

ITINERARY FOR TRAVELING TO TIMBERLINE:

Depart: Sunday, June 27th

Meet at 6:00am at the Fellowship Student Center. We will depart by 6:30am or sooner, if possible.

Arrive in Winter Park: 9:00pm approximately

ITINERARY FOR TRAVELING HOME:

Depart CO: Friday, July 2nd at 10:30pm

Return to FBC: Saturday, July 3rd around 2:00pm

Parents: The students will call when they get close to the Student Center; therefore, please make arrangements for someone to be available to come to the church to pick them up.

WHAT TO BRING:

Sleeping linens are provided

CLOTHING GUIDELINES:
